

Conference Information

COVID-19 Prevention Measures

Onsite participants are asked to wear their name tags at all times during the conference sessions and breaks. Additionally, a face covering (mask) must be worn at all times. At the entrance of the conference venue, your temperature will be taken, and hand sanitizer will be widely available.

Registration

Registration will take place on November 27 (Friday) and 28 (Saturday) between 12:00–13:00 KST and November 29 (Sunday) between 9:00–10:00 am KST in the lobby in front of Grand Ballroom A (Floor 3). Onsite participants will receive a conference package that includes a conference program book, name tag, t-shirt, and conference bag.

Session Guidelines

Program Changes

Changes made to the program after the printing of the conference program book will be displayed on the notice board located in the area in front of Grand Ballroom A (Floor 3) and online on the notice board of the virtual conference platform. Please check the offline or online notice boards frequently for last-minute changes and cancellations.

Session Types

Keynote Speech

The keynote speech is 30 minutes in length (no time for Q&A).

Plenary

Plenary sessions are 50 minutes in length (40 minutes for the presentation and 10 minutes for Q&A). All plenary sessions are livestreamed in the Grand Ballroom (Floor 3).

Featured Sessions

Featured sessions are 40 minutes in length (30 minutes for presentation and 10 minutes for Q&A). All of the featured sessions are livestreamed in the Grand Ballroom (Floor 3) as one of the concurrent presentations.

Concurrent Sessions

Each paper, teaching demonstration, workshop, or symposium is a 20-minute, 30-minute, 40-minute, or 60-minute presentation, respectively, with a Q&A through online chatting. The two Asian teachers panel discussions are each 60 minutes long. The assessment workshop by the British Council is 2 hours long. Two 1-hour EBS (Korea Educational Broadcasting System) presentations on AI PengTalk are made as special presentations.

Poster Sessions

Poster sessions are 60 minutes long. All e-posters can be viewed on the virtual conference platform, and onsite poster sessions will be held in the poster corridor on Floor 2.

AsiaTEFL 2020 Virtual Stamp Tour

A Virtual Stamp Tour will be held throughout the conference. Check your stamp missions on the virtual conference platform; collect 20 stamps by accomplishing 20 missions online. Ten people will get \$5 USD discount toward the 2021 AsiaTEFL membership fee.

Complimentary Refreshments

Bottled water, assorted drinks, and individually packaged snacks will be served free of charge in the lobby in front of Grand Ballroom A (Floor 3) throughout the conference. Meal boxes will be provided for onsite participants in Grand Ballroom C (Floor 3).

Virtual and Onsite Exhibition Booths

During breaks, participants are welcome to browse and experience AI-based EFL/FL learning programs and hologram presentations on Floor 3.
